


## Instructions for the submission of symposium proposals

Abstract for symposium proposals should be submitted by the convener(s) of a symposium, after registration to the conference. Once the symposium proposal will be accepted, then the each presenter in the symposium will be required to submit an abstract of the single presentation, mentioning the symposium title.

Symposia will be allocated **90 minutes** time slot (1 hour and half).

After having registered to the conference by creating your account on the Conftool submission platform you are able to submit the symposium proposal: just log in and click on “Submit your abstract/Your submissions”, and then in the following window click on the “Proposed symposium” link

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### IMPORTANT THINGS:

- The abstract should not exceed 500 words (all included)
- The abstracts of symposium proposals should contain a short introduction of the theme and aims of the symposium (theoretical and/or practical background rationale and implications), plus a list of the proposed contributions (with authors' name and a preliminary title of each single presentation that will be included in the symposium).
- Once the proposer(s) of a symposium will get the acceptance notification, they should remind to each presenter to proceed with their individual registration and abstract

submission. In this case, they will have to indicate that their submission is part of a proposed symposium, and specify the title and of the symposium they are part of.
